- Complete the application and submit it by the deadline
- Must be a 501c3 organization
- May apply for a grant of up to \$10,000
- Must serve in one of the three priority areas: Future Ready Workforce, Inclusive Sustainable Economy or Resilient Communities
- Priority will be given to organizations that demonstrate services to Kings Mountain residents
- Organizations that have not previously received grant funding in 2024 from Albemarle will be prioritized
